Joining Blocks

IMPORTANT NOTE: When sewing blocks and vertical lattices together to form rows, be careful to make final adjustments to landscape pieces that need to match each other and pull any flip pieces out of the way before you sew.

1. Assemble Row 2 first. Sew April block, April lattice and May block together (again — watch to pull any flip pieces out of the way of the seamlines). Next join May lattice and June block. From your horizontal lattice fabric (Row 3 sky fabric) cut two strips, one 3" x 38", and one 3" x 19". Sew the longer one to the bottom of April block/April lattice/ May block unit. Sew the shorter one to the bottom of May lattice/June block unit. At this point complete the applique of river in both sections, stopping $\frac{1}{2}$ " before the sewing line at the edge of the blocks. **This way you can make any adjustments that are needed to match the landscape pieces that continue from one unit to the other.**

The bold portion above was left out of the 2005 directions for constructing the quilt.
