For then there will be great tribulation such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be. (Matthew 24:21)

By now we should all be aware that we are living in very perilous times. Most families have been disrupted in one way or another. **Nothing is the same as it was even a year ago.** We are entering into the shaking of all mountains and valleys until only the Kingdom remains.

Jesus warned us that many false prophets would arise (Matthew 24:24). Many false prophets have arisen predicting a big revival, but Jesus never said He would revive anyone or anything. That change from a child of the night to a child of the day is tremendous. That change means pain, tribulation, rejection, separation from loved ones, and suffering. Our options are not many, and they aren’t pleasant. **“If we lose our life, we gain it or if we save our life we lose it”** (Matthew 10:39). **In both instances life as we know it is history!**

I was writing personal letters to some of the stars (teachers) that showed us the way in the night season and God said, **“Don’t write anymore. It’s too late and they won’t hear anyway.”** They will all meet their master and then each will have to decide. Will he or she be willing to leave his ministry, his hope, his family, or will he perish with the world?
