"THEN I PASSED BY YOU AND SAW YOU, AND BEHOLD, YOU WERE AT THE TIME FOR LOVE SO I SPREAD MY SKIRT OVER YOU AND COVERED YOUR NAKEDNESS. I ALSO SWORE TO YOU AND ENTERED INTO A COVENANT WITH YOU SO YOU BECAME MINE." EZEKIEL 16:8

Covenant..... it is a word almost never heard in American life today, for it speaks of a commitment to Christ and to one another which is deeper and more demanding than most of us are willing to make. This is a quote from *The Light and the Glory* by Peter Marshall, recommended reading which can be ordered from Piecemakers.

The only real Christians are those who have made a COVENANT with God and with a body of people — a commitment that will ultimately cost one his/her life. Not physically, but a death to all we are, all we think, all we love, all we hate, all self will, jealousies, self aggrandizements, all independence — all must go, for none of our spiritual blood or flesh can enter into the kingdom called America. For God is calling America into a COVENANT relationship with Him.

Acts 3:25 — "It is you who are the sons of the prophet, and of the COVENANT which God made with your fathers, saying to Abraham, 'And in your seed all the families of the earth shall be blessed'."

Jesus Christ is the only real ethnic cleanser. I pray every Christian, Muslim, Jew or any other false god religion humble his/her heart and mind before the living God lest He use other methods to cleanse this nation.

This nation is a nation under God in name only. God is about to make our words and deeds match. You had better not call yourself a Christian unless you are so committed to the living God that your iniquity has been removed, that your thoughts have become His thoughts and that your ways and His ways are the same. All hypocrisy (acting like something we are not) is the thing of the past.

Quoting again from *The Light and the Glory*, telling about the founders of this country, "Something special had been born among them in the midst of all the dying — they had shared the love of Jesus Christ in a way that only happens when people are willing to suffer together in His causes. This was what they had come to the wilderness to find and now none of them wished to leave it." Thus it is with the Piecemakers. We have found something so precious in loving and caring for one another and suffering with one another, as God pours out His Grace in return for our total dedication to Him.

From *The Light and the Glory*, "It is astonishing to see how few people it takes to begin a cycle of repentance, followed by the return of God's grace. When a group of people, no matter how small or ordinary, is willing to die out to their selfish desires, the life which comes out of that death is immeasurable, and continues to affect lives far into the future. These people instead of aspiring to greatness (which is often the goal today), truly want nothing more than to serve God's people, not by a ministry, or by teaching but by a living example of Christ on earth thus fulfilling the saying of our great example who said, 'I am among you as one who serves,' God will use people such as these mightily to show the way in the building of His New Promised Land."

Marshall closes his book with this, "In our hearts, we also know that God has called us Christians to a horizontal as well as vertical COVENANT. But the cost of turning from our independent ways — of being willing to hear God speak to us through the lips of others, of coming into the light by exposing the hidden sins of attitude or thought, of humbling ourselves by admitting where we are wrong — is more than most of us care to

pay. 'United We Stand' is one of our nation's mottos, and, 'Out of One, Many' is another. But these are true words only because a few of the first Americans were willing to pay the price.

So we modern Christians must humble ourselves and renew the horizontal as well as the vertical aspect of our COVENANT with God. If we do this, He will hear, and forgive our sins, and heal our land. It can still happen. Our forefathers have broken the trail for us, and shown the way. Their call is our call. If just a fraction of

us Americans choose to go the COVENANT way, it will suffice. Then each of our lives will be filled with the light of Him who said, "I am the light of the world." and if the candle power of each COVENANT Christian were to be joined to the whole, the result would truly be the blaze of glory which John Adams foresaw. America would yet become the citadel of light which God intended her to be from the beginning!!!!" End of quote...
