But even if we or an angel from heaven preach any other gospel to you than what we have preached to you <u>LET HIM BE ACCURSED</u>. So now I say again — If anyone preaches any other gospel to you than what you have received <u>LET HIM BE ACCURSED</u>. (Galatians 1:8-9)

God is sending out a warning to the people and to the pastors. To the pastors he is saying, "What kind of a gospel are you feeding the people????" To the people he is saying, "Wake up! You will be responsible for the gospel you are listening to." I know of no pastor at present who is preaching the gospel Paul preached!!! That is: "If we are planted with Him in the likeness of His death, certainly we shall also be in the likeness of His resurrection." (Romans 6:5) Also, "If we suffer with Him we shall also reign with Him." (2 Timothy 2:12)

A large percentage of Christianity is sitting in churches so dead they do not know one can know Christ right here and now. Then there are some pastors who preach an evangelical message. The people receive Christ and then die on the vine for the pastor says, "Now you are saved." The pastor gives them no vision of the journey from this world into the Kingdom of God. Jesus came into the world to take us (by metamorphosis) back to the source, our Father. Any other gospel is a false gospel and Jesus says, "LET ANYONE PREACHING SUCH A GOSPEL BE ACCURSED." (Galatians 1:9)

BELIEVE ME WHEN I SAY THAT ONCE YOU ARE UNITED BACK TO OUR FATHER YOU WILL NEVER AGAIN POINT FINGERS AT THE PRO-ABORTIONISTS OR THE HOMO-SEXUALS. For to do so only lets me know that you also have fallen short of the glory of God and are living in sin. You just don't get the picture that there is nothing good in man. He must relinquish his old life just as a seed must yield its life if it is to become that fruit-bearing tree.

If you are preaching the gospel Paul and Jesus preached, you should be living it. (1 Corinthians 9:14) If one is living the gospel this should be his lifestyle:

1. Now all who believed were together and had all things in common and sold their possessions and goods and divided them among all as anyone had need. Acts 2:44-45

Notice that the BELIEVERS lived together communally, sharing everything, calling nothing their own. If you do not believe this for today for the Body of Christ you are considered an unbeliever.

2. For in the resurrection (the Kingdom of God) they neither marry nor are given in marriage but are like the angels. Matthew 22:29-33

Jesus prefaces this scripture by saying that the only reason they did not know or believe this is because they knew not the scriptures or the power of God. He knew their wicked hearts and knew they would try to wrestle their way out of what He was about to say. We come to God single file and are responsible for our own life only. No one can be blamed for what we have done.

3. You are not your own. You were bought with a price. 1 Corinthians 6:19-20

This scripture is prefaced by a most astounding admonishment. He is warning us that sexual intercourse is of the flesh. If we are joined in the flesh to anyone we are joined to a harlot. We are to be joined to the Lord in the spirit and to flee sexual intercourse (Romans 6:16-18). I know already that this is going to cause a lot of screaming and hollering because we love to hang onto our lust and covetry. Did He not say that lust was of the

world? That we are to overcome that world and come out of it??? Please do not call us about these scriptures. God is judging America! And lust, whether it be for wife, husband, neighbor's wife or for anything or anyone... lust is never satisfied. That flesh and blood will not enter the Kingdom (1 Corinthians 15:50). If marrying satisfied our lust, why is there so much adultery? And why do you look at another body to covet if you are married and satisfied? And those who are Christ's have crucified the flesh with its passions and lusts. (Galatians 5:24) Please, if you are not allowing your flesh to be crucified, do not call yourself a Christian, for by so doing you are using the Lord's name in vain. So if you are living the gospel, your body belongs to God, and you will pay the price of you own lust and greed and your own desires and your own will and ways to have Him own you.

4. But if you are a respecter of persons ye commit sin. James 2:9

For God is no respecter of persons. Acts 10:34

Because we are to represent our Father and be holy as He is holy, we too are to be no respecter of persons. Do you have more respect for the rich than the poor, for the Catholics more than the Protestants, for the clean more than the unclean? Do you cater to the rich in hopes of a little windfall? Are you a man to all men and treat all the same? If you have passed that test then let me ask you several more questions. Are you a respecter of persons when it comes to your blood family? Do you hold them dearer to your heart than any other person? Hang onto your hats — God's two-edged sword is about to go across the land enlarging the hearts of the people.

I could go on and on describing this wonderful world called the Kingdom of God. However, I think I have given you enough to pray about.

The false teachers and prophets have preached free grace, free salvation, free access to the throne of God, free redemption — everything instant and easy, but the fact is the price is very dear. You will pay it all to the last farthing. The cross that we pick up daily should decrease us to ashes. All we knew in life is dead. For

you are dead (as final as it is when we die physically) and your life is hid with Christ in God (Colossians 3:3). Then out of the ashes — lo and behold — comes a beautiful new creation living in a new world — truly the worm turned into a butterfly (Romans 12).

Expect judgment to fall on the false teachers and prophets who have not prepared their flock. The day of the Lord is no respecter of persons and is very awesome and terrible.

Now, knowing all of this I want to ask you a question. Are you still going to glibly pray, "Thy Kingdom come, Thy will be done"? He just might take you seriously.

How important is it to hear the pure gospel? **IT IS A MATTER OF LIFE OR DEATH.** 1 Corinthians 4:15 says we are begotten by the gospel. 1 Corinthians 15:1-2 says we are saved by the gospel. 2 Timothy 1:10 tells us that death is abolished through the gospel and life and immortality are brought to life through the gospel. 2 Corinthians 4:3 tells us that if the message you just read is hidden from your understanding it is veiled because you are perishing. Cry out to God and He will open the eyes of your understanding.

Because we are at the end of one age (world) and entering another, there are many books out on near death experiences, out of the body experiences, seeing angels and New Age experiences. Beware of these false books that teach there is a way to heaven other than the cross. Remember, our old nature cannot enter the Kingdom of God. Only a totally new creation can live in God's Kingdom. He is calling us back home. Let us submit ourselves to the chastening, cleansing fire of the Holy Spirit. There are many obstacles and many hardships along the way... HOWEVER, THOSE WHO ENDURE UNTIL THE END SHALL BE SAVED.
