This World vs. The Resurrection (Resurrection — also known as heaven or the Father)

Did you know that the world you are born into was never meant to fulfill you? Did you know that everyone born into the world (which the Bible calls hell) cannot go to heaven any more than a worm can fly? The worm must change into a butterfly, become an entirely different nature the same as we must, if we want to get to heaven.

In the scriptures God refers to the world in which we are born as "this world", hell, the grave. Anyone living in "this world" is controlled by the devil. Jesus calls the world He rules over "that world", the resurrection, heaven, the rest or eternal life.

We all want to get to heaven. Are you aware of God's method of making us members of His kingdom??? Believe me it is not leading a good life, being good, dying physically and then boom — we are in heaven. If that was true our own works could get us there.

Our only way to heaven is through the cross which, through obedience to the Holy Spirit, changes our nature from an entity that lives in "this world" to one who inhabits God's kingdom or the kingdom of heaven.

Let us check the scriptures to see what the Holy Spirit says about marriage.

For in the resurrection they neither marry nor are given in marriage, but are like the angels of God in heaven (Matthew 22:30). Now notice this scripture follows a story of a woman who has married seven times thinking, undoubtedly, that marriage would fulfill her life. Isn't it odd that the scriptural reason for one getting married is to keep one from burning. Not if you "fall in love", not to raise children, but to supposedly squelch our lust. If marriage is the antidote to lusting then why all the adultery? Surely it did not help President Clinton.

In Luke 20:35, He makes a definite differentiation between this world which is known as hell or the grave, and that world which is the resurrection or heaven. He says that world is eternal life where one never dies. But this I say brethren, the time is short so that from now on even those who have wives should be as though they had none. (1 Corinthians 7:29)

But he who is married cares about the things of the world, how he may please his wife. (1 Corinthians 7:33)

The unmarried woman cares about the things of the Lord, that she may be holy both in body and in spirit. But she who is married cares about the things of the world — how she might please her husband. (1 Corinthians 7:34)

Do you not know that those who love this world hate God? (James 4:4) Or should I say, one who cares about the things of this world, hates God. The natural man cannot know God, and yet we find that if we truly love God with all our heart the Father will birth us by His will — birth us into His kingdom.

I want to ask you a question. Do you ever hear a pastor tell any couples they marry about these scriptures?? Are the pastors the ones spoken of in scripture who will not enter in themselves, so they keep everyone they pastor in the dark? Did it ever dawn on you that God might be talking to the human race? Where once marriage was blessed of God it is now finished and people are trying to make something work that God is putting asunder.

In the book of Ephesians Paul is telling the formula for marriage. Then he tells us he is referring to the mystery of Christ and the church. Divorce is not the answer to "no marriage". Seeking first the kingdom of God will add you to a community where God will place you in a live, vibrant family where He and He alone satisfies our every need.

Do you want to have your life fulfill all that Christ came to do??? Or are you content to be just another religious dead man called a Christian???
