

AND WHAT WILL YOU DO IN THE DAY OF MY VISITATION?????

Isaiah 10:3

This very question infers that there are as many different reactions and choices we make when God visits His people as there are people. **WE ARE IN THE DAY OF GOD'S VISITATION.** Most of Christianity is missing it the same as the Jews did 2000 years ago. Soon there will be a wailing and gnashing of teeth as they see the unbeliever sitting at the table with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, and they are in outer darkness. Remember, without **charity** (which is the capstone of our perfection (Colossians 3:14)) we are like sounding brass. There is no English word that aptly describes charity. It definitely is not love. Charity is the fullness of Christ's character. I have yet to hear a clear trumpet sound. All the revelation is as nothing if our life has not come under the Lordship of God, our Father.

After Job's painful ordeal with God, he finally had to confess that "your visitation has preserved my spirit". (Job 10:12)

In the days of the Charismatic Move the believers were those who had received Christ as their Savior and were baptized in the Spirit and spoke in tongues. Now the **BELIEVERS** are those who are together and have all things in common. "Now all who believed were together, and had all things in common." (Acts 2:44) This, my dear friends, is Kingdom living. We can come up with all the revelation, with all the sermons, the big congregations, the gigantic T.V. ministries, the worldwide teaching ministries, but if we still own anything, even our own life, we are like sounding brass, and our talk and teaching is idle talk with no life in our words or our spirit. Remember also, dear sojourner, the days of faking it are over and God is demanding some real people, born of Him. The rays of His visitation are beginning to shine. It is too late to prepare for it but if forewarned you may be yet able to humble yourself so as to make it into the kingdom. When the shepherd is smitten and

your congregations are scattered, run for your life, you pastors, do not turn back to the destruction of your soul. You cannot save anyone. Even your own family will have to each one shift for itself.

Every man, woman and child will be compelled to come up to the Feast of Tabernacles — the final feast for mankind. As God begins to build the Body of Christ, because many men are married to wives of another spirit or women married to husbands of another spirit they will have to "put away all these wives and those who have been born to them according to the counsel of my master and of those who tremble at the commandment of our God; and let it be done according to the law. Arise, for this matter is your responsibility. We also will be with you. Be of good courage and do it." (Ezra 10:3-4) So the building of the temple has begun and those who are unbelievers will have to be left behind and woe unto those who are with wife or husband who is an unbeliever for they are considered a pagan even though he/she has received Christ and been baptized in the Spirit.

NOW LET US REVIEW THE VISITATIONS THAT HAVE TAKEN PLACE IN THE LONG HIS- TORY OF MANKIND.

We are about to see the full visitation of God that will shake the human race to its quick. Nobody will escape the terribleness of God toward the proud and arrogant and the kindness of God for the humble. Pray when He again utters "Let there be light" that you are on the Lord's side and have the same spirit as Caleb and Joshua. The graves are opening and there is a coming together of the dry bones — some to life and some unto condemnation.

UNLIKE REVIVALS, VISITATIONS ALWAYS AFFECT THE ENTIRE HUMAN RACE.

Because we are in the final formation of mankind this visitation will encompass all the past visitations. When the disciples asked Jesus when and how all this would take place He did not hesitate to tell them about Lot and the destruction of Sodom and Gomorrah, the destruction of the flesh in the days of Noah, Moses and the burning bush and of course, Jesus himself entreating with the people.

IF YOU HAD KNOWN, EVEN YOU, ESPECIALLY IN THIS YOUR DAY, THE THINGS THAT MAKE FOR YOUR PEACE. BUT NOW THEY ARE HIDDEN FROM YOUR EYES. FOR THE DAYS WILL COME UPON YOU WHEN YOUR ENEMIES WILL BUILD AN EMBANKMENT AROUND YOU, SURROUND YOU AND CLOSE YOU IN ON EVERY SIDE AND LEVEL YOU AND YOUR CHILDREN WITHIN YOU TO THE GROUND, AND THEY WILL NOT LEAVE IN YOU ONE STONE UPON ANOTHER, BECAUSE YOU DID NOT KNOW THE TIME OF YOUR VISITATION. (Luke 19:42-44) These are some pretty weighty words He is speaking to the Christians. Now let me give you the positive side of this scripture. Notice He talks about the children “within you” — the stones one upon another are “within you”. So we see the visitation is “within us”. He will visit each human and annihilate the natural man which brought forth the human race from the seed of Adam. That means we will belong to a new family unless we are destroyed with HIS COMING. Are you hearing this or are you still in denial thinking you can live yet in the “good ole days”?

Notice also in the above warning that His visitation is the only real peace we can have for the kingdom of God is peace, joy and righteousness in the Holy Ghost.

PREVIOUS VISITATIONS AND THE CONSEQUENCES OF EACH:

God’s visitations took place in Genesis, the gospels and Revelation.

In the days of Noah, God presented Himself in a visitation that affected the whole human race. He destroyed all flesh because it was harvest time. The flesh was putrid and corrupted.

His visitation through Abraham ended with the destruction of Sodom and Gomorrah, that part of man where iniquity, intrigue and wickedness lies, but it also gave birth to faith — that faith that causes man to endure the dealings of God until the change comes.

When the time came for the deliverance of the children of Israel from Egypt, God took a nation from within a nation the same as He is doing today. He had not only prepared Moses, but He also had the hearts of the people prepared to leave all behind and follow a leader who wasn’t quite sure he knew the way to go or where He was going. Egypt was never the same again nor were the children of Israel ever the same again.

Who could have ever told the Jews who so religiously paid homage to God that the God they were worshipping was a God of their own making? And that God was visiting His people through a kinfolk of theirs, a common man called Jesus, the son of Mary and Joseph. He was a man of truth and He spoke the truth in parables. He spoke unadulterated truth. His words were Spirit and life, and He showed everyone the way to Life by example, and then left the world with no fanfare, no funeral music, no sermon, and yet His life left its mark in the conscience of man so when His name is mentioned, everyone knows who is being spoken of. He will forever hold man guilty for the sin of Adam until we, too, die the death He died.

So my dear friends — we are now in the visitation where all is summed up and taking place within us, and He is coming for what He so graciously calls His bride, His wife, His holy city. Are you among those who have paid the same price He paid to be called worthy to enter His Kingdom? Are you willing to have Him rule over you? Or are you among those who say, “We will not have this man rule over us”. And then He said, “Take these who do not want me to rule over them and slaughter them.” (Luke 19:27) These are the days we are living in. I promise you that man as we know him is history. He will not pity them who do not turn to Him nor will He spare them. But for those who love Him and want Him as their Lord of righteousness, those who love the truth, He will come with healing in His wings and gather them under His banner of charity.



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
