

## Through Wisdom is thy House Builded

*“And by understanding it is established; and by knowledge shall the chambers be filled with all precious and pleasant riches..”*

The hour has arrived when God is putting together living stones to build His house. A house in which He can live. He is using people to help him build the house. Many are catching the drift of this great happening and are starting programs for the poor, for the homeless, for the alcoholic — some are forming churches — all busy, busy supposedly building the house of God.

However, there are certain credentials to be had, certain requisites one must have to help in the building of God’s house.

Let me say first, all the good works will not suffice. The five fold ministry has always been anointed flesh; so that is useless. So let us proceed and find out who will be capable to build His house.

First remember that the stones used to build the house are dead and must be brought to life by the builder for did He not say, “Ye also as living stones are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ.” (1 Peter 2:4)

Secondly, please understand, just because you met Christ, does not mean you are alive unto God. You are alive unto Christ to die with Him and be resurrected by God, the Father.

James 3:15 tells us that the only wisdom man has is earthly, sensual and demonic. For man is of the earth, earthly. Only “in Christ” do we find the wisdom to build the house of God.

1 Corinthians 2 says some interesting things about the wisdom that will build God’s house. First off he (Paul) tells us that no flesh shall glory in His presence. So we must be willing to be crucified in the flesh and in our affections and our lusts before we can lead others into the ark. Please remember that removing grave

clothes is an important part of building God’s house. To remove grave clothes takes wisdom from God. Lazarus and Joshua are two good examples who could not be free until the grave clothes came off and in both cases God told the ones he fellowshiped with to remove his grave clothes.

Notice that Paul came in weakness and in trembling, not with enticing words of men’s wisdom but in the demonstration of discernment of intents and motives of the heart. He said he had not the wisdom of the world, but the hidden wisdom of God ordained before the world unto our glory. This wisdom searches all things, even the deep things of God. We speak not in the words which man’s wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.

Now for the coup-de-grace the natural man cannot understand the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him. Notice this is the Spirit of God which is given only to those who have had the world crucified to them, that contains the things of God.

My dear friend, you cannot bring someone out of hell if you are still in it yourself. And Paul calls the world “hell” and the “grave”. You must be willing to leave all; be willing to be changed into a new creation; have new thinking, new speaking, new understanding, new relationships to God and to man. If God, Himself came and handed the kingdom of heaven to anyone, he or she would think it was hell for our natural man was never meant to dwell in heaven. So much for the fairy tale of going to heaven when we die.

Have I stirred you up enough to make you want to move on into the resurrection, or are you so double dead with the riches and religion of the world that you cannot hear — really hear what is being said???

God wants a house to live in. Will you make a home for Him and help Him build a corporate building or will this be a time in the events of men when once more there will be “no room in the inn”? Perhaps God called men and women to come into the arc and when they

refused, He decided He would take the animals as they are easier to entreat? Let us be willing to turn our back on our old life and enter into His presence thereby becoming that new creation planned in God’s heart before the foundations of the world.



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
