

Facts of Life

Skimming the scum out of the gospels being preached.

Hebrews 4 — Let us therefore fear, lest a promise being left us entering into his rest, any of you should seem to come short of it. For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them; but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard it. Although the works were finished from the foundation of the world. For he that has entered into his rest has ceased from his own works, as God did from His.

The Charismatic Move ended some ten years ago and the leaders are playing “charismatic” as if it were still going on.

Can you name for me one Charismatic leader from Graham to Smith to Mumford to Katz (to name a few) who have entered the rest spoken of in Hebrews 4???. They have all fallen short of the glory — the rest. All are still considered sinners, all are buried in the cesspool called “the church age” — carrying on as usual, keeping their families captive also. We are living in times as disruptive as the days back in the garden when the human race fell captive to the rule of the prince of the world.

Being restored back to God is just as painful and drastic as the fall.

These are facts pertaining to Christ and God’s people that can only be understood by experience. Revelation is a mystery until experienced. The mysteries are only revealed to the saints — Ephesians 3:13 — are only comprehended by the saints.

“The rest” is the inheritance of those who are willing to part with family, friends, ministry, soul, and blood.

Do you see now why so few are willing to go that way, to open the womb of a new age? The price is too great to pay.

Not going the full way with God is an unforgivable sin, but concocting another gospel other than Paul has or the one I have is doubly sinful. People love a gospel

that has no price to pay — one that keeps them in hell, the place of our birth.

1. The kingdom of God is righteousness, peace and joy, not a place to go to. However you must go on a spiritual journey to attain the change which culminates in a new inner man whose character is filled with joy, peace, and righteousness.

2. The kingdom of heaven is within you (Luke 17:21). If you truly met Christ, the second coming is inevitable. Much like a worm that has come to its time of maturity — the butterfly is the result of fulfilling the law of changing that worm into a butterfly. So it is with Adam changing into Christ. Those still looking for a second coming either perished because of lack of a vision or never really met Christ the first time. Perhaps they were touched by the light of John the Baptist and never went on to meet Christ.

We in the Charismatic Move saw many walking in the 70’s and 80’s John the Baptist’s light. What a far cry from the one preceding the coming of the Lord 2000 years ago who bellowed, “You vipers and you snakes, who told you to flee from the wrath to come?” That message is still being shouted from that voice crying in the wilderness, for America and the world are about to see the wrath of God on an ungodly world.

3. The only doorway into the body of Christ is through the cross. What is the cross???? Well, I will tell you what it is not. It is not the two railroad ties pounded

together at the top of a hill or the myth of Jesus carrying it up a hill. The word crucify (*Strong's Concordance*) — to extinguish lusts and selfishness. Galatians 5:24 — “And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts.”

Now, my dear friends, you know that intercourse in marriage or outside of marriage makes the two become one flesh. So if you really belong to Christ, the flesh is extinguished and the marriage ends. Of course, all of you pastors and teachers who call yourselves Christian teach that there are no marriages in the resurrection. Or have you made up a gospel of your own to match your selfish commitment??? The evangelical message is “Come to Jesus, He will be the answer to all your problems.” Well, when I met Jesus I had no problems.

He was the cause of my family being shot all to hell, of my marriage of twenty-five years ending (although we struggled together for another twenty-eight years, each growing in the knowledge of the Lord and experiencing the cross daily).

So, Christ is the cross. The cross is the end of a life and the beginning of a new life. The only sign of the cross you can make is death to self and a new creation. All else is mockery and blasphemous. The only rapture there is is death to self and a new creation, and all other preachers of another gospel will be burned in fire as God comes as a consuming fire.
