My name is Michael F-----. I'm writing to you to thank you for the paper and envelopes you sent me in July. That was way helpful. I was also going to mention that I was here in Chino when the riot happened. I had completely no involvement whatsoever. Each and every one of us had a complete body search for injuries, scrapes, scars, bruises, etc. I had none at all, by the way. The dorm I was in was the one (Joshua Hall) that was on fire. I truly believe it was God in Heaven who kept me safe. I remember before it happened I was sitting on my bunk and I could just see the tension and the races grouping up. That's when I said a little prayer.

Anyways, let me get to the next thing I wanted to tell you. Since August 8th we have been getting screwed around left and right. For 3 days we were stuck in the dog kennels. Let me explain what that is. It's a big cage for someone who is Ad-Seg to have their 1 hour yard time. Well they shoved 10 of us in there for 3 days. Some inmates stayed longer. But, when we arrived there the CO's made us give up our oranges — you know, our clothes. It was freezing at night and hot as hell during the day. All we had on was our boxers and shoes. We had to sleep on the cement with no blankets. Believe me, Marie, it was horrible. I'm so glad and thankful it was only 3 days. Then they moved us to this place called Y.T.S. I guess it's a youth authority that's been emptied out. It's right behind Chino Prison. And we've been here going on 2 months. This place only has 1 man cells, but 2 of us are in here. I have to sleep on the floor; I could get bitten by a rat or a spider. One shower a week, no canteen, no personal hygiene products, it is a complete nightmare. And it seems like there's maybe a lawsuit here. Our title 15 handbook says no floor sleepers.

Marie I'm just trying to be heard. I see Piecemakers has helped a lot of inmates out. I'm one of them. I just wanted to let you know how things are from this side of the walls. Thanks for taking the time to read this.

We are publishing your letter all over the internet and I am saying this:

If this is rehabilitation, pray tell me what punishment is. This is a letter from one of the prisons in a Christian country calling itself the land of the free and the home of the brave. The riots in Chino would never have happened if God's children had proper treatment. We as a nation have fallen from grace and are a disgrace to God, a disgrace to the world and just a disgrace period. What we do to the least of the brethren, we do unto Christ. Two bits the deputies responsible for the abuse and punishment are Christians.

God is watching all the abuse. People riot when things are just too disgusting. I personally feel all the prisons should start rioting. We have to die sometime and why not for a cause. God is not a God of punishment. And punishment never does rehabilitate anyone. Our only hope is God and Kerry will call there and find out what the hell is happening. Chino is known for its cruelty anyway. It is the worst hell hole other than OCJ.

Michael, the whole world is forcing us by its corruption to put our trust in God and Him alone. When He appears, the deputies who are torching you will pray for the rocks to fall on them. Here is an email that I wrote. And also there were 2 million marching on Washington in a tax revolt. None of the press covered it. Fox News was there and spilled the beans.

If we all stop paying taxes, you will be out of prison.

I will say good night. It is late and my eyes are droopy. Night, my love.
